Our Moms are well noted to tear raw materials into long strips, "twisty-tie" them onto their Clutch size 4 to 6 eggs backs, and fly distances back to make a nest. up to two clutches per year. I am hatched from an egg. We have 4-6 eggs laid between February and April. We are dull white and measure 23.5 mm by 17.3 mm. We are incubated for about 23 days. As young birds we fledge after 43 days. How long does it take me to grow up and how long do I live **Breeding Season** Young birds fledge after 43 days. We can live for at least 10 to 15 years. What kind of family life do I have? We live in flocks and eat throughout the day and take frequent baths. Names for: Adult male- Male What do I eat and when do I eat? Adult female- Female .We need to be fed and watered each day. Young- Chicks We eat seeds and pellets, supplemented with fresh fruit, vegetables and greens. Group:- Flocks Who are my predators?
