Where am I from?

I am native to North and northwest Africa but also found in Southern Italy and Sicily. My habitat is deserts, grasslands and adjoining forests. I live under rocks, in crevices or in burrows I build myself. I like to have plenty of ground cover to hide in.

How am I born?

After a gestation period of about 112 days my mother gives birth to usually two or three of us. We nurse from teats on the sides of her body away from her quills. We will nurse for about 31/2 months. My mother is able to mate every 35 days but only produces two or three litters every year.

Breeding Season

How long does it take me to grow up and how long do I live? I reach sexual maturity at about 9-18 months. I will get 2 - 3 feet from my head to my feet and weigh about

What kind of family life do I What do I eat and when do I eat?

I am cared for by my mother in a grass lined burrow until my quills harden fully and even then mother stays with me until I am fully grown. She is very dedicated and can be quite ferocious when protecting us. As an adult I will live a solitary life for the most part. Some of us live in pairs and may be found in small family groups in our dens.

What do I eat and when do I eat?

30-60 lbs. In the wild my life span is about 12 -15 years.

I am a herbivore most of the time, although on rare occasion I will eat meat. I am nocturnal and have very poor eye sight. I use my nose to find the roots, bulbs, and berries I like to eat. My sense of hearing is so good I can hear fruit dropping from the trees several yards away. Like all rodents, my teeth grow continuously throughout my life and I have to gnaw on bones and branches to keep them from growing to long.

Who are my predators?

Man, lions and tigers. Any animal that hunts me for food has to be very hungry to attack because of my sharp quills.



Comments:

I do not shoot my quills as some people think but they do detach easily and because of the barbs on the end are almost impossible to remove. I can rattle my quills to scare away predators and they make quite an alarming noise.
